

- Construction Notice -Peninsula Road Improvements (Phase 1)

Please be advised that Hazelwood Construction Services Inc., working on behalf of the District of Ucluelet, will be completing street upgrades in your area starting January 23, 2024.

Construction works include:

- Storm system replacement
- New protected bike track
- Traffic calming curb extensions
- Crosswalk safety improvements
- Relocation of road centerline
- Landscaping and hardscaping improvements

To assist with construction, traffic control along Peninsula Road will be Single Lane Alternating Traffic (each side taking turns through the construction zone). Some limited local road closures with detours will be required. Access for local residents and businesses within the construction area will be provided.

ALL BUSINESSES WILL REMAIN OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION

Every effort will be made to keep local disruptions to a minimum. Construction signs will be posted and flag persons will be on duty to assist with the traffic flow. Please exercise caution, obey all signage placed for your safety and follow the directions of the flag persons on duty. If you have young children, please advise them of the dangers and limited visibility of heavy equipment and trucks.

- Construction Notice -Peninsula Road Improvements (Phase 1)

General Considerations

- While there will be delays during peak travel times, through traffic will be permitted on Peninsula Road.
 - Traffic will be Single Lane Alternating Traffic (each side taking turns through the construction zone).
- Travel speeds will be lower in the construction zone and there will be some restrictions on turning from time to time.
- Pedestrians when present, priority is to be given through the site by TCP or qualified personnel.
- Cyclists when present, are to either (1) dismount and travel through work zone as pedestrian or (2) take the lane and travel ahead of vehicles when directed by TCP or qualified personnel.
- Typical hours of work for this project will be Monday to Friday, 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM (weather & conditions permitting), with work after hours and weekends as required.
- Construction noise and vibration should be expected during working hours.
- If you live in the area and have young children, please advise them of the dangers of construction and the limited visibility of heavy equipment and trucks.
- All businesses will remain open during construction.
