Day 2 Complete

The second day of flushing is now complete (Zone 2), and Public Works would like to thank you all for your patience and understanding as we continue to move forward with this process.

This type of aggressive flushing is a first for the District, and unfortunately we are not able to pin point exactly where, when or how it will affect other areas of town while we flush each zone.

Again, we wish to you remind everyone that while your street is being flushed please do not use your water or flush your toilet.

Once your street is complete, we advise to fully open cold water taps outside your home for 15 minutes until it clears.

Ultimately, this aggressive flushing will remove long term buildup in the water system, help improve water quality and restore capacity.

Day 3 – Friday April 21, 2017: Zone 3, will begin at 8:30 am

Streets affected include: Sea Plane Base Road, Harbour Crescent, Waters Edge, Lyche Road, Hemlock Street, Inner and Outer Basin, Water Front Drive.
