Council Highlights - April 10th/24th Meetings

An OCP Project Update was received by Council including indication that a draft OCP will be presented to Council at the May 22nd meeting.

Council congratulated Ken Webb on retiring after a 32-year career maintaining our local highways.

First, second, and third readings were approved for the 2018 – 2022 Financial Plan Bylaw and Annual Tax Rates.

Council provided clarity regarding the status of cannabis sales and production in Ucluelet including a zoning amendment to further clarify that these uses are not currently permitted in any zone within the municipality until clarification is received from other levels of government. A Public Hearing is scheduled for May 22nd at 6:30 pm in the George Fraser Room at the UCC.

Council approved renewal of a Temporary Use Permit to Black Rock Resort for staff housing as they continue towards development of permanent staff housing.
