



Spring Clean-Up Day

Saturday, May 27, 2017

The District of Ucluelet will be hosting a municipal “Clean-Up Day” on Saturday, May 27, 2017 for “residential” properties located within the municipal boundary. Strata & Commercial properties are not eligible for this service. The intention is that residents can dispose of items that are not normally picked up through regular garbage collection.

The following materials will be picked up and are to be sorted into piles as follows:

Metals

- Metal furniture – padding and combustibles must be removed
- Other small metal articles
- Fridges, stoves, water tanks, etc.

Combustibles & Yard Waste

- Furniture – wooden or fabric covered
- Carpets and rugs (18” x 48” max)
- Wooden fencing – all wire and metal must be removed
- Leaves, grass, garden waste (not to exceed 10 regular bags)
- Branches & brush - must be cut to 4 foot lengths by 2 feet max., secured together with twine (not to exceed 10 bundles)

All materials for pick up shall be neatly piled beside the public road or lane starting Thursday, May 25th and no later than 8:00 am, May 27, 2017.

Please Note: There may be different vehicles picking up the various materials.

The following are **not acceptable** and **will not be removed** as part of the clean-up:

- Recyclable materials
- Building materials
- Gyproc
- Furnace oil tanks
- Car batteries and tires
- Propane/Fuel Tanks
- Items over 10 feet in length
- Household/hazardous wastes/pesticides
- Construction materials
- Styrofoam
- Used oil, paints or paint
- Car bodies or parts
- Utility trailers
- Large satellite dishes
- Electronics

Property owners/tenants whose items are out after 8:00 am and/or unacceptable items MUST remove their items by 8:00 am on May 29, 2017 or removal will be effected at **the owner's expense.**
