



Water Restrictions Lifted

Our community's water system relies on the natural recharge of our groundwater system and a supplementary creek system. While we live in an area with high rainfall, seasonal fluctuations and increasing demand increased the length of our water restrictions this year. The District has a Water Master Plan in place to address the long-term viability of our water system.

Water table monitoring and creek level monitoring by Staff show water supplies to be recharging to satisfactory levels. Therefore, water restrictions will be lifted effective November 3, 2017.
