District Office Reopening

The District office is gradually reopening but we ask residents to please limit walk-in enquiries. Please email or call the Staff with your enquiry and for information about paying your taxes visit https://ucluelet.ca/community/finance.

If you need to visit us in person, the District Office is open between **1:00 PM and 4:00 PM**, Monday to Friday (except on statutory holidays).

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- only one member of the public may enter the District office at a time;
- 2 metre distance must be maintained between visitors at all times;
- visitors must wash or sanitize hands before and after attending the office; and
- visitors must follow the directional arrows.

Do not enter the District office if you:

- have a fever, chills, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, new muscle aches, new headache, or a sore throat;
- have travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days; or
- are in close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19 or is experiencing any symptoms identified above.

Playgrounds Officially Reopen

On June 2nd the Provincial and the Regional Health Authorities set out guidelines for playground use. Please note that playground equipment is not being cleaned or disinfected. We ask residents to continue to keep our Community safe by following COVID-19 playground etiquette.

- If you are sick please do not enter the playground;
- 2 metre distance between parents and guardians should be maintained;
- Children should clean their hands before and after using the playground; and
- Avoid overcrowding and clustering.
