## **BC Restart Plan - Phase 3**

The Province announced on June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 that we are now in <u>Phase 3 of the BC Restart Plan</u> which permits domestic travel to Ucluelet. Accommodation providers are open and are required to have safety plans in place. The District asks that all visitors respect the safety measures recommended by their accommodation provider and the British Columbia Provincial Health Officer. We also ask that you respect the concerns and territories of our Nuu-chah-nulth neighbours, the Ucluelet First Nation and Toquaht Nation.
