
Provincial Health Orders

On February 5th Dr. Bonnie Henry extended the <u>province-wide COVID-19 restrictions</u>, including the Provincial Health Order on Gatherings and Events. This means that the current restrictions will continue, and it's not the time for non-essential travel.

It may not be okay to travel or visit friends. However, we can all still enjoy our local amenities like the new Spring Cove Interpretative Trail with our household members. The Ucluelet Recreation Department has also organized a treasure hunt on February 15th, where residents will have to solve riddles to receive free ice cream! We would like to acknowledge and thank the Province of British Columbia for supporting BC Family Day here in Ucluelet and encourage residents to keep an eye out on social media for more information.

BC's COVID-19 Immunization Plan

So far, BC has administered 145,567 doses of vaccine. Phase 1 of the <u>BC COVID-19 Immunization</u> <u>Plan</u> focuses on vaccinating those most vulnerable to severe illness, like residents of long-term care facilities, 87% of whom have received the vaccine. General population immunization will occur during Phases 3 and 4 of the Plan.
