
COVID-19 Update - March 26, 2021

Vaccination Update

On March 24th the first vaccination clinic was held at the Ucluelet Community Centre. Many seniors had the opportunity to receive their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Island Health has not announced dates for the whole community clinic in Ucluelet, but the District expects to receive information soon. COVID-19 Restrictions Update - Gatherings and Events Order



On March 23rd Dr. Henry further eased restrictions on outdoor social gatherings. Under the amended Gathering and Events order, religious worship services and funerals may be held outdoors. Up to 50 people may attend these gatherings, plus 2 extra people to make sure the rules are followed. COVID-19 Plans and Protocols must be in place and there are special rules about masks. These changes are in addition to the March 11th announcement that groups of up to ten people may gather outdoors. Please note, that these ten people must always be the same ten people. Also, indoor gatherings of any size are still prohibited, and non-essential travel is not recommended.
