Peninsula Road - Road works: Stage one continued: Concrete curb & driveway placement Week of June 10, 2024

Thank you for your patience as we continue to build the new infrastructure as part of the ongoing construction on Peninsula Road.

You may have noticed that we have shifted from underground works to aboveground works. We will be starting with the process of the placement of new concrete curbs, sidewalks, and driveways. We will then move onto new asphalt paving for the bike path and roadway. Completing the works will be the new landscaping.

Stage one - Concrete Driveway apron & Sidewalk placement

Due to the nature of concrete and the time it takes to cure (reach a usable strength) we require that no vehicles cross the concrete for a time of 48hours. We will work with you to maintain access to your homes and your businesses.

On Monday June 10th, we will starting the process of pouring the driveway aprons & adjacent sidewalk panels in front of your house &/or business.

What this means to you - you will lose access to / from your driveway for 48hours from the date the concrete in front of your house is poured. Every effort will be made to open access as soon as possible.

In most cases, you will be able to park on the opposite of the road to your house. We will endeavor to keep one of the driveway access to your place of business open at all times.

Please note the above schedule is weather dependent. Every effort will be made to keep you apprised of schedule changes.
