Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian Citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day June 28, 2025;
- Resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law

Campaign Expense and Third-Party Advertising Limits

The expense limit for candidates established by Elections BC for the 2025 councillor by-election is \$5,398.92. The third-party advertising limit is \$809.84.
