

## **Notice to Residents**

Bowerman Construction will be commencing work on the "Larch Road Active Transportation Improvements" project for the District of Ucluelet starting on March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024, with completion expected by June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

As a resident in the vicinity of the construction activity we would like to take this opportunity to notify you of a few construction details, as well as provide you with information to ensure your safety.

Typical construction work hours for this project will be Monday to Friday, from 7am to approximately 5pm. However, we may have to work outside these typical hours or on a Saturday to complete a critical piece of infrastructure but will ensure we are working within the hours of the District's noise bylaw.

Larch Road will become a one-way street with traffic flowing **EASTBOUND ONLY** while we work within the westbound lane and ditch. We ask that pedestrians utilize the shoulder of the eastbound lane in order to safely pass the work zone and for bicycle traffic to either take the lane, or dismount and proceed as a pedestrian. All roads will be made fully passable at the end of each days shift.

Please use the utmost due care and attention while driving/walking/bicycling within the vicinity of the construction zone and obey all posted traffic control signage as it is crucial to the safety of the construction crews, yourself, and your fellow motorists/pedestrians.

This project will involve the use of heavy equipment and large gravel trucks. Trucks entering the site will be given instructions to drive slowly and with care. If you have children, please advise them of the dangers of heavy equipment, and to not play on the job site or near stored materials.
