Easter Egg Craft

Have a try at dyeing Easter eggs with food colouring and shaving cream this year!

What you need:

- Can of shaving cream (not gel)
- Shallow bowl (food colouring may stain your metal bowl, use glass if possible)
- Food colouring
- Tooth pick or stick
- Hard boiled eggs

Directions:

- Hard boil eggs in a pot and cool.
- Evenly layer 1 inch of shaving cream at the bottom of a bowl.
- Trickle droplets of food colouring into the shaving cream.
- Use a toothpick or stick to swirl the colours together making a tie dye pattern.
- Roll the eggs around in the shaving cream and let sit for 5-10 mins.
- Wipe off the cream and voila!

Chicken Egg Drop

What you need:

- 4 baskets or bowls
- 2 hard boiled or plastic Easter eggs per player

How to play:

- Teams should be lined up on one side of the yard. (or living room)
- Place a basket in front of each team with 2 eggs per player.
- Place two empty basket at the other end of the yard. (or living room)
- Members from each team must place an egg between their legs and race each other to the other side of the yard dropping their egg into the basket without using their hands.
- The players then run back to their team unless they have dropped the egg.
- If an egg is dropped, they must restart the race.
- Once players) successfully drop their egg into the basket and return to their team, the next player then begins.
- The first group to finish wins!

Unicorn Bark

What you'll need:

- White chocolate
- Food colouring
- **Sprinkles**
- Baking tray
- Pot
- Spoon

Directions:

- In a pot, melt your white chocolate over the stove.
- Once melted, separate into 4 different bowls.
- Leave one bowl of white chocolate and colour the other bowls of melted chocolate with food colouring of your choice.
- Using a spoon, blob the different chocolate colours near each other on a baking tray.
- Smooth and swirl the colours together and decorate with sprinkles.
- Freeze for 1 hr.
- Break up bark into pieces and enjoy!
