How:	Nomination documents may be delivered by hand, by mail or by other delivery service, or by fax or email (elections@ucluelet.ca). The deadline for receiving nomination documents is 4:00 p.m., September 11, 2026.

Nomination documents may be obtained from the District of Ucluelet Municipal Office during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays and weekends) throughout the nomination period (9:00 a.m., September 1, 2026, to 4 p.m., September 11, 2026) and will also be posted on the District's website at <https://ucluelet.ca/>

Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian Citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 17, 2025;
- Resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law
